2. Before travelling to WAM, please be aware that the State of Hawai'i requires your vaccination status to be uploaded prior to the flight. To upload this information please visit travel.hawaii.gov. Once your information has been uploaded, you will be provided with a QR code and an exemption status for the purposes of travel.

The Hilton Waikoloa Village Protocols
